WHEREAS, Highly engaged in his community, Mr. Cloud was 15 16 president of the Yucca Neighborhood Association, which he founded in 2007; he further distinguished himself by hosting various 17 events, such as fundraisers and holiday food giveaways, and by 18 leading area Boy Scout troops; he also coached boys and girls Little 19 League teams for several years, and he played an instrumental role 20 21 in establishing a booster club at Hillcrest Middle School to purchase athletic equipment for students; moreover, he was an avid 22 23 supporter of the Judge Edward S. Marquez Library, and he advocated for the development of E. L. Williams Park; and 24
