3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 13.031, Election Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
6	(f) A volunteer deputy registrar appointed under this
7	section may serve as a volunteer deputy registrar throughout the
8	state regardless of which county appointed the deputy registrar.
9	The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures to implement this
10	subsection.
11	SECTION 2. Section 13.033(b), Election Code, is amended to
12	read as follows:
13	(b) If a person is to be appointed, the registrar shall
14	prepare a certificate of appointment in duplicate containing:
15	(1) the date of appointment;
16	(2) the statement: "I,, Voter Registrar
17	for County, do hereby appoint as a
18	volunteer deputy registrar [forCounty].";
19	(3) the person's residence address;
20	(4) the person's voter registration number, if any;
21	(5) a statement that the term of the appointment
22	expires December 31 of an even-numbered year; and
23	(6) a statement that the appointment terminates on the
24	person's final conviction for an offense for failure to deliver a

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- 1 registration application and may terminate on the registrar's
- 2 determination that the person failed to adequately review a
- 3 registration application, intentionally destroyed or physically
- 4 altered a registration application, or engaged in any other
- 5 activity that conflicts with the responsibilities of a volunteer
- 6 deputy registrar under this chapter.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 13.037(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (a) A person may not receive compensation from any [the]
- 10 county for service as a volunteer deputy registrar unless
- 11 compensation is authorized by the commissioners court of that
- 12 county.
- 13 SECTION 4. Section 13.038, Election Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- Sec. 13.038. POWERS GENERALLY. (a) A volunteer deputy
- 16 registrar may distribute voter registration application forms
- 17 throughout the county and receive registration applications
- 18 submitted to the deputy in person.
- 19 <u>(b) A volunteer deputy registrar may distribute a voter</u>
- 20 registration application in the form prescribed by the secretary of
- 21 state under Section 31.002 throughout the state and receive an
- 22 application in that form submitted to the deputy in person,
- 23 regardless of the county in which the application was printed.
- 24 <u>(c) The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures to</u>
- 25 implement this section.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 27 last day of the legislative session.
