Lee, and other Confederate 9 10 heroes; the second day of March, "Texas Independence Day"; 11 (2) 12 (3) the 21st day of April, "San Jacinto Day"; 13 (4) the 19th day of June, "Emancipation Day in Texas," 14 in honor of the emancipation of the slaves in Texas in 1865; the 27th day of August, "Lyndon Baines Johnson (5) 15 Day," in observance of the birthday of Lyndon Baines Johnson; 16 (6) the Friday after Thanksgiving Day; 17 18 (7) the 24th day of December; [and] the 26th day of December; and 19 (8) (9) the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 20 21 November of an even-numbered year. 22 SECTION 2. Section 662.021, Government Code, is amended to 23 read as follows: Sec. 662.021. DATES OF HOLIDAYS. A legal holiday includes 24

2 (1) a national holiday under Section 662.003(a); and
3 (2) a state holiday under Sections 662.003(b)(1)
4 through (6) and Section 662.003(b)(9).

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 6 last day of the legislative session.
