- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 161.0085, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, as added by S.B. No. 968, Acts of the 87th Legislature,
- 7 Regular Session, 2021, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 161.0085. COVID-19 VACCINE PASSPORTS PROHIBITED;
- 9 EXCEPTION.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 161.0085, Health and Safety Code, as
- 11 added by S.B. No. 968, Acts of the 87th Legislature, Regular
- 12 Session, 2021, is amended by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and
- 13 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 14 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), a [A] business
- 15 in this state may not require a customer to provide any
- 16 documentation certifying the customer's COVID-19 vaccination or
- 17 post-transmission recovery on entry to, to gain access to, or to
- 18 receive service from the business. A business that fails to comply
- 19 with this subsection is not eligible to receive a grant or enter
- 20 into a contract payable with state funds.
- 21 (c-1) A venue as defined by Section 327.001, Business &
- 22 <u>Commerce Code</u>, or a business that is permitted or licensed to sell
- 23 alcoholic beverages at retail for on-premises consumption may
- 24 require an individual to provide documentation certifying the

- 1 individual's COVID-19 vaccination status or post-transmission
- 2 recovery on entry to or to gain access to the venue or business.
- 3 (d) Notwithstanding any other law <u>and except as provided by</u>
- 4 Subsection (c-1), each appropriate state agency shall ensure that
- 5 businesses in this state comply with Subsection (c) and may require
- 6 compliance with that subsection as a condition for a license,
- 7 permit, or other state authorization necessary for conducting
- 8 business in this state.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 14 legislative session.
