A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring a member of the
- 2 legislature to be in the state in order to receive a per diem during
- 3 a legislative session.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 24(a), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Members of the Legislature shall receive from the Public
- 8 Treasury a salary of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) per month, unless a
- 9 greater amount is recommended by the Texas Ethics Commission and
- 10 approved by the voters of this State in which case the salary is
- 11 that amount. Each member shall also receive a per diem set by the
- 12 Texas Ethics Commission for each day the member is in this State
- 13 during each Regular and Special Session of the Legislature.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2022.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring a member of
- 18 the legislature to be in the state in order to receive a per diem
- 19 during a legislative session."
