**IN RE: HB28** by Toth (Relating to curriculum, materials, and activities in public schools.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

Among other provisions, the bill would require certain local education agencies to make available information describing teaching materials and activities presented to students.

This analysis assumes that the costs associated with the bill's provisions could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

According to the Texas Education Agency, the bill provisions related to publishing information about teaching materials and activities could result in significant costs to school districts and charter schools.
