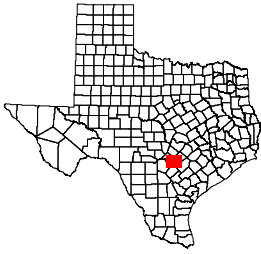




GUADALUPE COUNTY

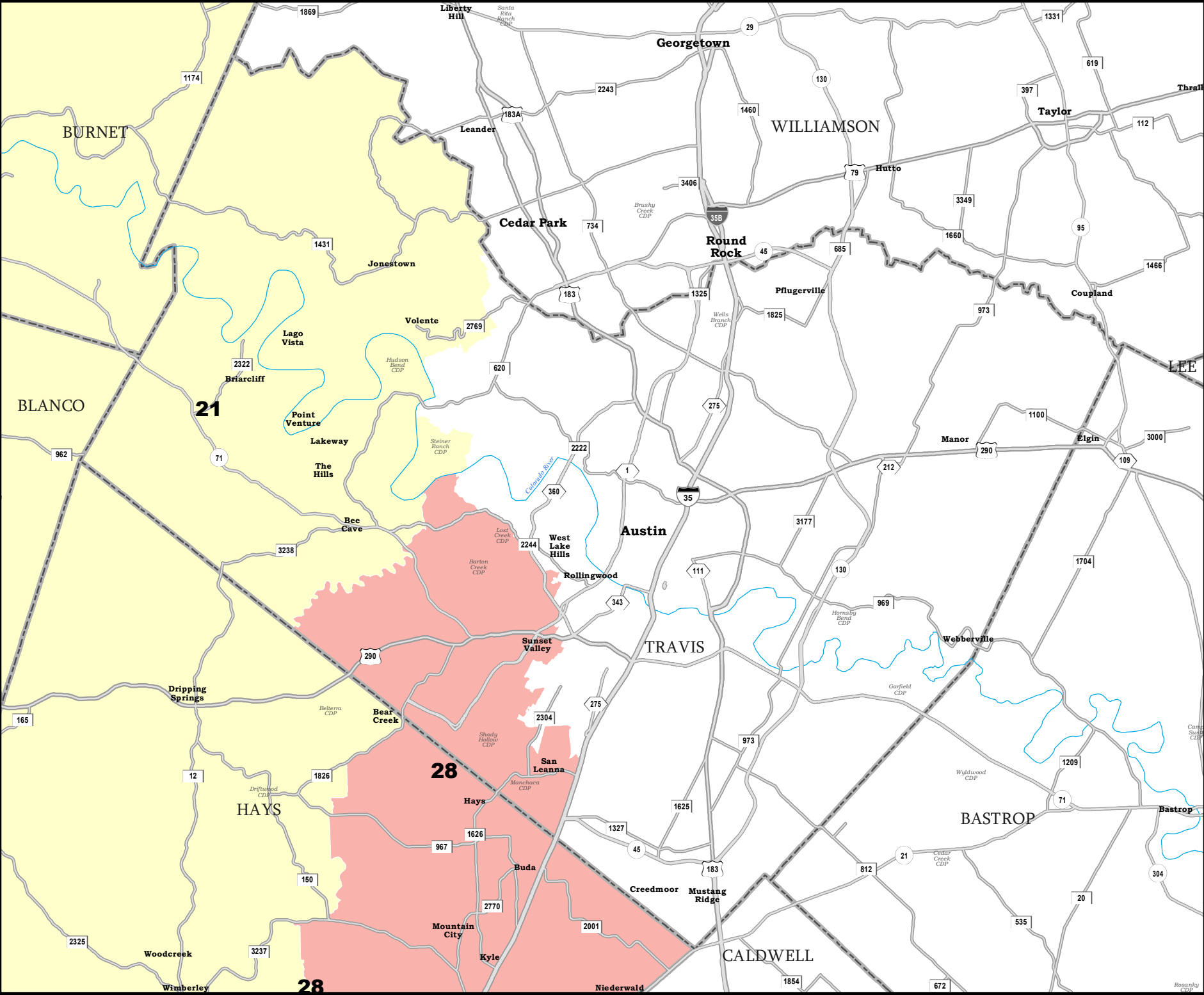

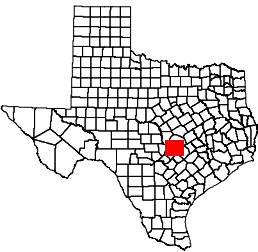

Because the MOE can only be calculated using whole block groups, all block groups with more than 50% of the population in a district are included in the analysis. The Red-118 report provides a summary of the block groups used in the analysis.

The percent for each CVAP population category is that group's CVAP divided by the CVAP total.

Numbers in parentheses are margins of error at 90% confidence level.
