Subtitle F, Title 10, Government Code, is amended by adding Chapter 2275 to read as follows: 7 CHAPTER 2275. MANDATORY VACCINATIONS PROHIBITED 8 Sec. 2275.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter: 9 (1) "Company" has the meaning assigned by Section 10 11 808.001. 12 (2) "Political subdivision" means a county, municipality, school district, special purpose district, or other 13 14 subdivision of state government that has jurisdiction limited to a geographic portion of the state. 15 16 (3) "State agency" has the meaning assigned by Section 609.001. 17 18 Sec. 2275.002. PROVISION REQUIRED IN CONTRACT. A state agency or political subdivision may not enter into a contract with a 19 company for goods or services unless the contract contains a 20 21 written verification from the company that it does not, and will not during the term of the contract, require, as a condition of 22 23 employment, an employee to receive any vaccination. SECTION 2. Chapter 2275, Government Code, as added by this 24

1 Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the 2 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before that date 3 is governed by the law in effect on the date the contract was 4 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that 5 purpose.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 7 last day of the legislative session.
