3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The
7	secretary of state shall implement a program to allow a person with
8	an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card
9	issued in this state to complete a voter registration application
10	over the Internet from a secure Internet website.
11	(b) The Internet website established under this section
12	<pre>must allow a person to submit:</pre>
13	(1) an initial application for registration; and
14	(2) an application to update a voter registration
15	record.
16	(c) When a person submits an application under this section,
17	the secretary of state shall compare the information provided by
18	the applicant against the Department of Public Safety records.
19	(d) The completed online application and information from
20	the Department of Public Safety, including the applicant's digital
21	signature, shall be provided to:
22	(1) the county voter registration office for the
23	county where the applicant currently resides; and
24	(2) the secretary of state for the statewide

- 2 (e) An application electronically submitted under this
- 3 <u>section is considered for all purposes as an application submitted</u>
- 4 by mail under this title. A digital signature given as provided by
- 5 secretary of state rule meets the signature requirement under

- 7 (f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 8 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 10 last day of the legislative session.
