## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle B, Title 3, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 319A to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 319A. REDISTRICTING LEGISLATION
8	Sec. 319A.001. PRINCIPLES GOVERNING LEGISLATIVE
9	REDISTRICTING. (a) In enacting legislation adopting or modifying
10	a redistricting plan for the election of the Texas Senate, the Texas
11	House of Representatives, the State Board of Education, or the
12	members of the United States House of Representatives elected from
13	this state, the legislature shall ensure that the plan, including
14	any modifications to the plan, conforms to the following
15	<pre>principles:</pre>
16	(1) a plan shall avoid unnecessarily dividing counties
17	and municipalities in the formation of districts, and district
18	boundaries shall to the extent practicable be coterminous with the
19	boundaries of counties and municipalities;
20	(2) a plan shall to the extent practicable keep intact
21	communities of interest defined by social, economic, racial,
22	ethnic, cultural, industrial, commercial, and geographic

(3) a plan must protect minority voting rights in

- 1 accordance with applicable state and federal constitutional and
- 2 statutory requirements, including the federal Voting Rights Act of
- 3 1965 (52 U.S.C. Section 10101 et seq.); and
- 4 (4) the districts in a plan must be equal in population
- 5 as nearly as practicable in accordance with the other principles
- 6 described by this subsection.
- 7 (b) The principle described by Subsection (a)(1) applies to
- 8 a plan for the election of the Texas House of Representatives in
- 9 addition to the requirements of Section 26, Article III, Texas
- 10 Constitution. District lines shall to the extent practicable be
- 11 coterminous with the boundaries of counties and municipalities.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 13 last day of the legislative session.
