## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to prohibiting the imposition of municipal ad valorem
3	taxes on property that does not receive full municipal services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 43, Local Government Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 43.909 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 43.909. MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAXATION IN CERTAIN AREAS
8	PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality may not
9	impose a tax on real property in an area that does not receive full
10	municipal services. The prohibition may be waived by written
11	agreement between the municipality and a landowner in the area. A

- 12 written agreement applies only to property owned by the landowner
- 13 who enters into the agreement.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an ad valorem tax year
- 15 beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 17 last day of the legislative session.
