## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a grant program in the Parks and Wildlife Department for
3	outreach to certain underserved populations; making an
4	appropriation.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Parks and Wildlife
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 13.024 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 13.024. GRANT PROGRAM FOR OUTREACH TO UNDERSERVED
9	POPULATIONS. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Nonprofit partner" has the meaning assigned by
11	<u>Section 11.201.</u>
12	(2) "Underserved population" means any group of people
13	who are:
14	(A) low income, inner city, or rural as
15	determined by the last census;
16	(B) minority;
17	(C) youth, including youth at risk and youth with
18	a physical, developmental, or intellectual disability or mental
19	illness; or
20	(D) female.
21	(b) The department shall develop and administer a grant
22	program for outreach to underserved populations to provide money to
23	municipalities, counties, and nonprofit partners for use to
24	increase:

- 1 (1) access to and use of the department's parks,
- 2 recreational areas, cultural resource sites and areas, and open
- 3 space areas by underserved populations; and
- 4 (2) participation of underserved populations in the
- 5 outdoor, historical, cultural, and recreation safety activities of
- 6 the department.
- 7 (c) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 8 donations from any public or private source for the purposes of this
- 9 section.
- 10 (d) The department shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 11 administer the grant program established under this section,
- 12 including rules regarding:
- 13 (1) the form and content of an application for a grant;
- 14 (2) grant eligibility requirements; and
- 15 <u>(3) permitted uses of grants.</u>
- SECTION 2. (a) The amount of \$180,000,000 is appropriated
- 17 from the general revenue fund to the Parks and Wildlife Department
- 18 for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2021, for the
- 19 purpose of funding the grant program for outreach to underserved
- 20 populations established under Section 13.024, Parks and Wildlife
- 21 Code, as added by this Act.
- (b) The unexpended balance of the money appropriated by
- 23 Subsection (a) of this section is appropriated for the same purpose
- 24 for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2022.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 3 legislative session.
