5	SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as Caleb Rule's Law.
6	SECTION 2. Section 54.354(a), Education Code, is amended to
7	read as follows:
8	(a) A person is eligible to receive education benefits under
9	this section if the person is one of the following eligible
10	survivors of an individual listed under Section 615.003, Government
11	<pre>Code:</pre>
12	(1) a surviving spouse; or
13	(2) a surviving [minor] child who:
14	(A) on the date of the listed individual's death
15	is younger than 25 years of age; and
16	(B) if the child is not a biological or adopted
17	child of the listed individual, was claimed as a dependent on the
18	individual's federal income tax return for the year preceding the
19	year of the individual's death [as defined by Section 615.001,
20	Government Code].
21	SECTION 3. Section 54.354(a), Education Code, as amended by
22	this Act, applies beginning with costs charged for the spring 2022

- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 8 legislative session.
