A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the inclusion of plans in the governor's homeland

3 security strategy for the protection of this state's international

4 border through the enforcement of federal immigration laws.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 421.002, Government Code, is amended by

7 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

8 (b-1) The specific plans for protecting this state's

9 international border under Subsection (b)(5) must include plans for

10 state enforcement of federal immigration laws if an official of a

11 <u>federal agency charged with enforcing federal immigration laws has</u>

12 publicly stated that the agency is unable to enforce those laws in

13 this state or if a determination is made that the federal agency

14 charged with enforcing federal immigration laws is unable to

15 enforce those laws and that failure to enforce those laws

16 jeopardizes the security of this state. The plans must provide the

17 specific conditions and criteria that must be met before making a

18 determination described by this subsection and require that the

19 <u>determination</u> be <u>published</u> in the <u>Texas</u> Register. In this

20 <u>subsection</u>, "federal immigration laws" means federal law relating

21 to aliens, immigrants, or immigration, including the federal

22 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.).

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the

24 last day of the legislative session.
