- Sec. 478.0053. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY
- 24 REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN LARGE EVENTS [VENUES]. Section
- 25 478.0051(b)(1) does not apply to an event described by Section
- 26 478.0001(3)(J) [478.0001(3)(H)]. If an endorsing municipality or
- 27 endorsing county requests the office to make a determination under

- 1 Section 478.0102 for an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(J)
- $2 \left[\frac{478.0001(3)(H)}{2}\right]$ , the remaining provisions of this chapter apply to
- 3 that event as if the event satisfied the eligibility requirements
- 4 under Section 478.0051(b)(1).
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 10 legislative session.
