A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to observing
- 2 standard time year-round or observing daylight saving time
- 3 year-round based on the results of a statewide referendum.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 74 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 74. (a) The legislature by general law may:
- 8 <u>(1) hold a statewide referendum that allows the voters</u>
- 9 to indicate a preference for either:
- 10 (A) observing standard time year-round; or
- 11 (B) observing daylight saving time year-round;
- 12 <u>and</u>
- 13 (2) enact a law based on the results of the referendum
- 14 providing for the state to observe standard time year-round or to
- 15 observe daylight saving time year-round.
- 16 (b) A statewide referendum described by Subsection (a) of
- 17 this section that is held on the same day as the election on the
- 18 constitutional amendment to add this section to this article is
- 19 <u>hereby validated.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 21 submitted to the voters at an election to be held May 7, 2022. The
- 22 ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the state
- 24 to conduct a statewide referendum to allow the voters to choose

- 1 between observing standard time year-round and observing daylight
- 2 saving time year-round and authorizing the legislature to enact
- 3 legislation that gives effect to the option preferred by a majority
- 4 of the voters voting in the statewide referendum."
