6 Ohio; after graduating from Sidney Lanier High School in 1963, he  
7 earned a business degree from Kent State University, where he was

10 master's degree in business from Indiana University as part of the  
11 Air Force Institute of Technology program; and

14 Supply that would span 30 years; outgoing and respected by all who  
15 knew him, he became a top-selling medical supply salesman for the

19 fulfilling marriage of more than five decades; he took great pride

23 and Gavin; in his leisure hours, he enjoyed traveling, boating, and

2 husband, Phil Loveless lived a life that was rich in the intangibles  
3 that matter most, and he will forever hold a special place in the
