## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The observance of Hindu Heritage Month in October 2 2021 provides an opportunity to celebrate the enduring legacy of one of the world's oldest religious traditions and the many ways 3 that its practitioners have enriched our society; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Nearly one billion people worldwide, including around 80 percent of the population of India, belong to the Hindu 6 7 faith; Hinduism refers to a diverse set of beliefs, practices, and rituals that date back thousands of years and that vary across 8 social groups and regions; the multifaceted, ever-evolving nature 9 of Hinduism distinguishes it from belief systems that derive their 10 11 doctrine from a single text, and its complexity leads many to 12 embrace it not simply as a religion but as a way of life; and WHEREAS, People of Hindu faith make up one of 13 14 fastest-growing immigrant communities in the United States; they invaluable contributions as business 15 made 16 professionals, and innovators, advancing human knowledge in every area from science, astronomy, and medicine to art and literature, 17 while also sharing the vibrancy of their culture with the Western 18 world; Hindu Americans, including those of Indian descent, have 19 20 added immeasurably to their communities through their unique 21 culinary traditions, music, styles of dress, and festivals such as Holi and Diwali, and they have further introduced fellow citizens 22 23 to the benefits of yoga, meditation, mindfulness, and other
