RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Residents of Grand Prairie gather each year on
- 2 Martin Luther King Jr. Day to celebrate the important legacy of the
- 3 civil rights leader at a parade sponsored by the Grand Prairie
- 4 NAACP, the City of Grand Prairie Parks, Arts & Recreation
- 5 Department, and the Grand Prairie Police Department; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 1983, the King Holiday Bill was signed into law,
- 7 making the third Monday in January a federal holiday; the
- 8 observance later became the only federal holiday also designated as
- 9 a national day of service with the signing of legislation to
- 10 encourage Americans to follow Dr. King's example by working
- 11 together to improve their communities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The son of a Baptist minister, Martin Luther
- 13 King Jr. earned his doctoral degree in theology; in 1955, he
- 14 organized the Montgomery bus boycott, the first major protest of
- 15 the civil rights movement, and he devoted himself wholeheartedly to
- 16 the cause; he led marches across the South to direct America's
- 17 attention to injustice and oppression, and although physical
- 18 attacks were a constant threat, he upheld the powerful principle of
- 19 nonviolent civil disobedience; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Dr. King's soaring oratory inspired people across
- 21 the country, and in 1963, at the massive March on Washington, he
- 22 delivered an address for the ages, outlining his vision of a better
- 23 America as the words "I have a dream" rang out over the crowd and
- 24 into history; the following year brought the ratification of the

- 1 24th Amendment, which abolished the poll tax, and the Civil Rights
- 2 Act of 1964, which prohibited discrimination in employment and
- 3 education and outlawed segregation in public facilities; that
- 4 October, Dr. King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize; and
- 5 WHEREAS, In observing this holiday, we focus not only on the
- 6 legacy of Dr. King, but also on the need to continue his work in
- 7 behalf of justice, peace, and equal rights for all; now, therefore,
- 8 be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
- 10 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby commemorate the annual
- 11 Grand Prairie Martin Luther King Jr. Day parade and extend to the
- 12 organizers and participants sincere appreciation for their
- 13 contributions.
