15 1981, to serve Arlington and the surrounding cities within the  
16 Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex; among its many accolades, Nu Pi Lambda  
17 has been named the Texas and Southwestern Regional Chapter of the  
18 Year; and

19           WHEREAS, For four decades, The Nu Pi Lambda Chapter of Alpha  
20 Phi Alpha Fraternity has played an important role in the lives of  
21 its members and the wider community, and the organization's  
22 dedication to helping young people achieve their educational goals
