1 WHEREAS, Fred Alonzo Rangel of San Antonio, an esteemed civic
2 leader and friend to many, passed away on October 2, 2021, at the
3 age of 66; and

4 WHEREAS, Freddie Rangel was born in Corpus Christi on
5 October 21, 1954, to the Reverend Frank Rangel Sr. and Sylvia
6 Rangel, and he grew up with the companionship of five brothers,
7 Rudolfo, Frank, Robert, Gilbert, and Richard; after graduating from
8 Memorial High School in San Antonio, he earned a bachelor's degree
9 in architecture from the University of Pennsylvania in 1978; he
10 later received a diploma in biblical studies from the Latin
11 American Bible Institute in San Antonio; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Rangel founded ADCO Master Builders in 1991, and
13 he served for many years as president and chief executive officer;
14 over the course of his tenure, he played an instrumental role in
15 building commercial and residential structures in the San Antonio
16 area; passionate about politics, he served as president of the
17 Republican Party of Bexar County, as a precinct chair, and as a
18 member of the State Republican Executive Committee; and

19 WHEREAS, A man of deep faith throughout his life, Mr. Rangel
20 served as youth minister at La Trinidad Assembly of God Church and
21 as associate minister at East Central Assembly of God Church; most
22 recently, he was an active member of Westover Hills Church, where he
23 volunteered countless hours with several ministries; and

24 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Rangel benefited from the

1 love and support of his wife, Debbie, and he took great pride in
2 their daughter, Amy; over the years, he had the pleasure of seeing
3 his family grow to include two grandchildren, Luna and Joaquin; in
4 his leisure time, he enjoyed playing golf, playing the guitar, and
5 going dancing with his wife; and

6 WHEREAS, Deeply devoted to his family and his community,
7 Freddie Rangel made a meaningful difference in the lives of his
8 loved ones and fellow citizens alike, and his contributions will be
9 fondly remembered for years to come; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
11 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the memory
12 of Fred Alonzo Rangel and extend heartfelt sympathy to all who mourn
