

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Tim Halfin has been deservedly recognized for his
2 role in locating a three-year-old boy who had gone missing in Grimes
3 County; and

4 WHEREAS, The child, Christopher Ramirez, had wandered into
5 the dense woods near his home in Plantersville on October 6, 2021,
6 prompting a massive search effort that involved a coalition of 48
7 agencies; despite searchers working around the clock, several days
8 passed with no sign of the missing toddler; and

9 WHEREAS, After hearing about the case at his Bible study
10 meeting, Tim Halfin decided to join in the search; on the morning of
11 October 9, he spotted Christopher about 10 yards into the forest on
12 the Halfin property; the youngster had traveled five miles from his
13 home, and although tired, hungry, and dehydrated from the journey,
14 he was otherwise unharmed; the news that he had been found alive and
15 safe brought immense relief to his community, and after being
16 treated at hospitals in Houston and The Woodlands, he returned home
17 to his loved ones; and

18 WHEREAS, By taking part in the search for Christopher
19 Ramirez, Tim Halfin helped avert what could have been a terrible
20 tragedy, and his actions have earned the profound gratitude of his
21 fellow Texans; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 87th Texas
23 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby honor Tim Halfin for his
24 assistance in the safe return of a missing child and extend to him
