1 WHEREAS, Angela Hale has been a leader in the fight for social
2 justice for members of the LGBTQIA+ communities in Texas, and her
3 efforts have made a positive difference in numerous lives; and

4 WHEREAS, A Dallas native, Ms. Hale is the founder and
5 managing partner of Red Media Group, a strategic communications and
6 public affairs company; she has assisted Equality Texas since 2015,
7 leading advocacy and communications strategy and serving as a
8 senior advisor; in addition, she served the organization as interim
9 CEO during summer and fall of 2019; she guided communications
10 strategy in support of the legalization of gay marriage for Akin,
11 Gump, Straus, Hauer, and Feld, and she has led business coalitions
12 in their battles to defeat dozens of discriminatory bills; and

13 WHEREAS, Ms. Hale began her career as an Emmy Award-winning
14 television journalist, employed by such large media corporations as
15 CBS and Viacom in Dallas, San Antonio, and Laredo, as well as
16 Florida; subsequently, she worked in politics in North Texas before
17 moving to Austin to become the top senior policy advisor and
18 communications and media operations executive in the office of the
19 Texas Attorney General; she also served as the senior policy and
20 communications executive for the speaker of the Texas House; her
21 expertise in government affairs, crisis communications, and public
22 relations allows her to advise a wide range of clients, from
23 international law firms and Fortune 500 companies to municipal
24 governments, economic development corporations, trade

1 associations, and nonprofit organizations; and

2 WHEREAS, Angela Hale is working to further inclusion and
3 equality in the Lone Star State, and she may indeed reflect with
4 pride on her many noteworthy accomplishments; now, therefore, be it
