- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The secretary of state shall conduct a
- 6 study regarding the practical effects of eliminating the gap
- 7 between the early voting period for an election and election day and
- 8 providing for the conduct of elections with a single election
- 9 period.
- 10 (b) The study must include:
- 11 (1) best practices and policies of states that conduct
- 12 elections with a single election period;
- 13 (2) a cost-benefit analysis comparing the use of hand
- 14 marked paper ballots, ballot marking devices, and direct recording
- 15 electronic voting machines in elections with a single election
- 16 period;
- 17 (3) comparison of the estimated costs of conducting
- 18 elections with a single election period versus the costs of
- 19 conducting elections with a gap between the early voting period for
- 20 the election and election day; and
- 21 (4) recommended statutory language for implementing
- 22 the conduct of elections with a single election period.
- 23 (c) The secretary of state shall, not later than January
- 24 1,2022, submit a report on the secretary's findings to the

- 1 legislature.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 7 legislative session.
