- 5 SECTION 1. Title 16, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Chapter 280 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 280. FORENSIC AUDIT OF 2020 GENERAL ELECTION
- 8 Sec. 280.001. FORENSIC AUDIT OF 2020 GENERAL ELECTION. (a)
- 9 The Secretary of State and Attorney General shall conduct a joint
- 10 forensic audit of the general election that took place on November
- 11 3, 2020.
- 12 (b) The joint forensic audit conducted under Subsection (a)
- 13 shall audit every precinct in each county where there is a
- 14 discrepancy between the total number of votes counted and voters
- 15 counted as having voted.
- 16 (c) The audit under this section must begin not later than
- 17 November 1, 2021, and be completed not later than February 1, 2022.
- 18 (d) Not later than March 1, 2022, the results of the audit
- 19 shall be submitted to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of
- 20 the house of representatives, and each member of the legislature
- 21 detailing any anomalies or discrepancies in voter data, ballot
- 22 data, or tabulation.
- 23 (e) This chapter expires April 1, 2022.
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- $4\,$ Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 5 legislative session.
