10	(1) "COVID-19" means the 2019 novel coronavirus

12	(2) "Local governmental entity" has the meaning
13	assigned by Section 554.001, Government Code.
14	(3) "State governmental entity" has the meaning
15	assigned by Section 554.001, Government Code.
16	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, a local governmental
17	entity or state governmental entity may, as a condition of
18	employment, require an entity employee to provide to the entity in
19	the form and manner prescribed by the entity documentation of the
20	employee's COVID-19 vaccination, including any recommended booster
21	dose of the vaccine.
22	(c) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
23	under Chapter 418, Government Code, may not suspend, limit, or
24	alter this section or an employment condition established by a

1 local governmental entity or state governmental entity under this 2 section.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect February 1, 2022.
