A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the governor's issuance of executive orders,
- 3 proclamations, and regulations regarding the wearing of face masks
- 4 or coverings during a declared state of disaster.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
- 9 the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations, and
- 10 regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
- 11 proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law.
- 12 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the governor may not
- 13 <u>issue an executive order, proclamation, or regulation under this</u>
- 14 chapter that prohibits an institution of higher education as
- 15 defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, school district,
- 16 open-enrollment charter school, municipality, county, or health
- 17 authority from adopting a policy or issuing an order requiring the
- 18 wearing of face masks or coverings during a declared state of
- 19 <u>disaster.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to an
- 21 order, proclamation, or regulation that is in effect on the
- 22 effective date of this Act or that is issued or renewed on or after
- 23 the effective date of this Act. An order, proclamation, or
- 24 regulation in effect on the effective date of this Act that

- 1 conflicts with the law as amended by this Act is void as of that date
- 2 and not enforceable against any person.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 8 legislative session.
