- 2 relating to sexual assault and incest exceptions to the prohibition

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 171.205, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 171.205. EXCEPTIONS [EXCEPTION FOR MEDICAL
- 8 EMERCENCY]; RECORDS.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 171.205, Health and Safety Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Subsections (a-1) and (b-1) and amending
- 11 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 12 <u>(a-1)</u> Sections 171.203 and 171.204 do not apply to an
- 13 abortion of a pregnancy that is a result of a sexual assault in
- 14 violation of Section 22.011 or 22.021, Penal Code, or of conduct
- 15 constituting an offense under Section 25.02, Penal Code.
- 16 (b-1) A physician who performs or induces an abortion
- 17 described by Subsection (a-1) shall make a written notation of the
- 18 <u>exception in the pregnant woman's medical file.</u>
- 19 (c) A physician performing or inducing an abortion under
- 20 this section shall maintain in the physician's practice records a
- 21 copy of the notations made under Subsection (b) or (b-1), as
- 22 applicable.
- SECTION 3. Section 171.205, Health and Safety Code, as
- 24 amended by this Act, applies only to an abortion performed or

- 1 induced on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 7 legislative session.
