5	SECTION01. Section 4.003(e), Election Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(e) The authority responsible for giving notice of the
8	election shall deliver to the secretary of state:
9	(1) a copy of the notice of a consolidated precinct
10	required by Subsection (b) not later than the date of the election;
11	<u>and</u>
12	(2) information for the secretary of state's database
13	of election information under Section 31.017 in an electronic
14	format required by the secretary of state.
15	SECTION02. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Election Code,
16	is amended by adding Sections 31.017 and 31.018 to read as follows:
17	Sec. 31.017. INTERNET DATABASE OF ELECTION INFORMATION.
18	(a) The secretary of state shall post on the secretary of state's
19	public Internet website a database containing information provided
20	by each authority responsible for giving notice of an election in
21	this state. The database must include the following information:
22	(1) the name of the authority;
23	(2) each office to be filled at the election;
24	(3) whether the office is elected at large or by
25	district; and
26	(4) the dates of the preceding and next election for
27	the office.
28	(b) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
29	implement this section.
