Amend **CSHB 1927** (house committee printing) by adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION \_\_\_\_. Sections 62.082(d) and (e), Parks and Wildlife Code, are amended to read as follows:

(d) Section 62.081 does not apply to:

(1) an employee of the Lower Colorado River Authority;

(2) a person authorized to hunt under Subsection (c);

(3) a peace officer as defined by Article 2.12, Code ofCriminal Procedure; or

(4) a person who:

(A) <u>is carrying</u> [<del>possesses</del>] a handgun [<del>and a</del> license issued under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, to carry a handgun]; or

(B) under circumstances in which the person would be justified in the use of deadly force under Chapter 9, Penal Code, shoots a handgun [the person is licensed to carry under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code].

(e) A state agency, including the department, the Department of Public Safety, and the Lower Colorado River Authority, may not adopt a rule that prohibits a person who <u>is not</u> <u>otherwise prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a</u> <u>firearm [possesses a license issued under Subchapter H, Chapter</u> <u>411, Covernment Code,</u>] from entering or crossing the land of the Lower Colorado River Authority while:

(1) <u>carrying</u> [possessing] a handgun; or

(2) under circumstances in which the person would be justified in the use of deadly force under Chapter 9, Penal Code, shooting a handgun.
