Amend HR 4 (adopting the permanent rules of the house) as follows:

- (1) On page 82, between lines 12 and 13, add the following appropriately numbered section:
- SUBSTITUTES FOR REDISTRICTING BILLS. A committee may not consider or recommend an amendment to, or consider or adopt a complete committee substitute for, a redistricting bill that establishes or changes the composition of any districts used to elect public officials unless the text of the amendment or substitute is made available on the committee's Internet website for at least 72 hours prior to the posted time of the hearing or meeting at which the amendment or substitute is considered, recommended, or adopted.
  - (2) On page 173, following line 27, insert the following:
- amendment to a redistricting bill that establishes or changes the composition of any districts used to elect public officials unless the amendment has been provided to the chief clerk, in a manner determined by the chief clerk under the direction of the Committee on House Administration, and was available in the chief clerk's office at least 72 hours prior to the time the calendar on which the bill appears is first eligible for consideration.
  - (3) On page 174, line 18, strike "and".
- (4) On page 174, line 23, strike the period and substitute "; and ".
  - (5) On page 174, between lines 23 and 24, insert:
- on the Internet may view any amendment required to be provided to the chief clerk under Subsection (g-1) of this section as soon as practicable after the amendment is provided to the chief clerk.
- (6) Redesignate provisions of the rules and references to those provisions as necessary.
