- 27 (A) paying the penalty to the court for placement
- 28 in an escrow account; or
- 29 (B) giving the court a supersedeas bond approved
- 30 by the court that:
- 31 (i) is for the amount of the penalty; and

- 1 (ii) is effective until all judicial review
- 2 of the board's order is final; or
- 3 (2) request the court to stay enforcement of the
- 4 penalty by:
- 5 (A) filing with the court a sworn affidavit of
- 6 the person stating that the person is financially unable to pay the
- 7 penalty and is financially unable to give the supersedeas bond; and
- 8 (B) sending a copy of the affidavit to the <u>board</u>
- 9 [enforcement committee] by certified mail.
