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1 completes a coherent sequence of courses in the plumbing trade that are offered through a career and technology education program under 2 3 Subchapter F, Chapter 29, Education Code, may apply for and take an 4 examination for a license as a tradesman plumber-limited license 5 holder. The board may not require the person to register as a 6 plumber's apprentice, pay any fee, or comply with Section 1301.354 7 or any other requirement of this chapter that applies to a person's 8 eligibility to apply for and take the examination. 9 (b) A student of any age enrolled in a high school is eligible to take the sequence of courses described by Subsection 10 11 (a) without registering as a plumber's apprentice, paying any 12 registration fee, or complying with Section 1301.354 or any other requirement of this chapter that applies to enrolling or 13 14 participating in those courses. (c) If an applicant described by Subsection 15 (a) 16 successfully passes the examination for a license as a tradesman plumber-limited license holder, the board shall issue the applicant 17 18 the license. 19 (d) The board shall develop the courses described by 20 Subsection (a).
