1 Amend C.S.S.B. No. 1 (house committee printing) in Article I  
2 of the bill, by adding the following appropriately numbered rider  
3 after the appropriations to the Commission on the Arts (page I-2):

4 \_\_\_\_\_. Stained Glass Museum in San Juan. (a) In addition to  
5 other amounts appropriated by this Act and notwithstanding Sections  
6 13.01 and 13.02 of Part 13, Article IX, of this Act, a total amount  
7 of \$2,000,000 of any money made available under the following laws  
8 and subject to appropriation from the state treasury is  
9 reappropriated to the Commission on the Arts to the extent  
10 consistent with conditions placed on the expenditure of that money  
11 by the federal government:

12 (1) Section 5001, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and  
13 Economic Security Act (CARES Act) (42 U.S.C. Section 801);

14 (2) Section 313, Coronavirus Response and Relief  
15 Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (Div. M, Pub. L. No. 116-260,  
16 134 Stat. 1182 (2020), reprinted in note, 20 U.S.C. Section 3401);  
17 or

18 (3) Section 2001, American Rescue Plan Act of 2021  
19 (Pub. L. No. 117-2, 135 Stat. 4 (2021), reprinted in note, 20 U.S.C.  
20 Section 3401).

21 (b) Out of money reappropriated by Subsection (a) of this  
22 rider, the Commission on the Arts may use the amount of \$2,000,000  
23 to award a grant to the Gelman Stained Glass Museum for the state  
24 fiscal year ending August 31, 2022, for the construction and  
25 maintenance of a parking lot adjacent to the museum in San Juan,  
26 Texas, to accommodate the hosting of community events.
