1 Amend S.B. No. 2089 (house committee report) by striking all  
2 below the enacting clause and substituting the following:

3 SECTION 1. Section 351.152, Tax Code, is amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 Sec. 351.152. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only  
6 to:

7 (1) a municipality described by Section  
8 351.001(7)(B);

9 (2) a municipality described by Section  
10 351.001(7)(D);

11 (3) a municipality described by Section  
12 351.001(7)(E);

13 (4) a municipality described by Section  
14 351.102(e)(3);

15 (5) a municipality that contains more than 75 percent  
16 of the population of a county with a population of 1.5 million or  
17 more;

18 (6) a municipality with a population of 150,000 or  
19 more but less than 200,000 that is partially located in at least one  
20 county with a population of 125,000 or more;

21 (7) a municipality with a population of 150,000 or  
22 more but less than one million that is located in one county with a  
23 population of 2.3 million or more;

24 (8) a municipality with a population of 180,000 or  
25 more that:

26 (A) is located in two counties, each with a  
27 population of 100,000 or more; and

28 (B) contains an American Quarter Horse Hall of  
29 Fame and Museum;

- 1           (9) a municipality with a population of 96,000 or more  
2 that is located in a county that borders Lake Palestine;
- 3           (10) a municipality with a population of 96,000 or  
4 more that is located in a county that contains the headwaters of the  
5 San Gabriel River;
- 6           (11) a municipality with a population of 99,900 or  
7 more but less than 111,000 that is located in a county with a  
8 population of 135,000 or more;
- 9           (12) a municipality with a population of 110,000 or  
10 more but less than 135,000 at least part of which is located in a  
11 county with a population of less than 135,000;
- 12           (13) a municipality with a population of 9,000 or more  
13 but less than 10,000 that is located in two counties, each of which  
14 has a population of 662,000 or more and a southern border with a  
15 county with a population of 2.3 million or more;
- 16           (14) a municipality with a population of 200,000 or  
17 more but less than 300,000 that contains a component institution of  
18 the Texas Tech University System;
- 19           (15) a municipality with a population of 95,000 or  
20 more that:
- 21                   (A) is located in more than one county; and  
22                   (B) borders Lake Lewisville;
- 23           (16) a municipality with a population of 45,000 or  
24 more that:
- 25                   (A) contains a portion of Cedar Hill State Park;  
26                   (B) is located in two counties, one of which has a  
27 population of two million or more and one of which has a population  
28 of 149,000 or more; and  
29                   (C) has adopted a capital improvement plan for  
30 the construction or expansion of a convention center facility;
- 31           (17) a municipality with a population of less than

1 6,000 that:

2 (A) is almost wholly located in a county with a  
3 population of 600,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a  
4 population of two million or more;

5 (B) is partially located in a county with a  
6 population of 1.8 million or more that is adjacent to a county with  
7 a population of two million or more;

8 (C) has a visitor center and museum located in a  
9 19th-century rock building in the municipality's downtown; and

10 (D) has a waterpark open to the public;

11 (18) a municipality with a population of 56,000 or  
12 more that:

13 (A) borders Lake Ray Hubbard; and

14 (B) is located in two counties, one of which has a  
15 population of less than 80,000;

16 (19) a municipality with a population of 83,000 or  
17 more that:

18 (A) borders Clear Lake; and

19 (B) is primarily located in a county with a  
20 population of less than 300,000;

21 (20) a municipality with a population of less than  
22 2,000 that:

23 (A) is located adjacent to a bay connected to the  
24 Gulf of Mexico;

25 (B) is located in a county with a population of  
26 290,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a population of  
27 four million or more; and

28 (C) has a boardwalk on the bay;

29 (21) a municipality with a population of 75,000 or  
30 more that:

31 (A) is located wholly in one county with a

1 population of 575,000 or more that is adjacent to a county with a  
2 population of four million or more; and

3 (B) has adopted a capital improvement plan for  
4 the construction or expansion of a convention center facility;

5 (22) a municipality with a population of less than  
6 75,000 that is located in three counties, at least one of which has  
7 a population of four million or more;

8 (23) an eligible coastal municipality with a  
9 population of 3,000 or more but less than 5,000;

10 (24) a municipality with a population of 90,000 or  
11 more but less than 150,000 that:

12 (A) is located in three counties; and

13 (B) contains a branch campus of a component  
14 institution of the University of Houston System;

15 (25) a municipality that is:

16 (A) primarily located in a county with a  
17 population of four million or more; and

18 (B) connected by a bridge to a municipality  
19 described by Subdivision (20);

20 (26) a municipality with a population of 20,000 or  
21 more but less than 25,000 that:

22 (A) contains a portion of Mustang Bayou; and

23 (B) is wholly located in a county with a  
24 population of less than 500,000;

25 (27) a municipality with a population of 70,000 or  
26 more but less than 90,000 that is located in two counties, one of  
27 which has a population of four million or more and the other of  
28 which has a population of less than 50,000;

29 (28) a municipality with a population of 10,000 or  
30 more that:

31 (A) is wholly located in a county with a

1 population of four million or more; and

2 (B) has a city hall located less than three miles  
3 from a space center operated by an agency of the federal government;

4 (29) a municipality that is the county seat of a  
5 county:

6 (A) through which the Pedernales River flows; and

7 (B) in which the birthplace of a president of the  
8 United States is located;

9 (30) a municipality that contains a portion of U.S.  
10 Highway 79 and State Highway 130;

11 (31) a municipality with a population of 48,000 or  
12 more but less than 95,000 that is located in two counties, one of  
13 which has a population of 900,000 or more but less than 1.7 million;

14 (32) a municipality with a population of less than  
15 25,000 that contains a museum of Western American art;

16 (33) a municipality with a population of 50,000 or  
17 more that is the county seat of a county that contains a portion of  
18 the Sam Houston National Forest;

19 (34) a municipality with a population of less than  
20 25,000 that:

21 (A) contains a cultural heritage museum; and

22 (B) is located in a county that borders the  
23 United Mexican States and the Gulf of Mexico;

24 (35) a municipality that is the county seat of a county  
25 that:

26 (A) has a population of 115,000 or more;

27 (B) is adjacent to a county with a population of  
28 1.8 million or more; and

29 (C) hosts an annual peach festival;

30 (36) a municipality that is the county seat of a county  
31 that:

1 (A) has a population of 585,000 or more; and  
2 (B) is adjacent to a county with a population of  
3 four million or more;  
4 (37) a municipality with a population of less than  
5 10,000 that:  
6 (A) contains a component university of The Texas  
7 A&M University System; and  
8 (B) is located in a county adjacent to a county  
9 that borders Oklahoma;  
10 (38) a municipality with a population of less than  
11 6,100 that:  
12 (A) is located in two counties, each of which has  
13 a population of 600,000 or more but less than two million; and  
14 (B) hosts an annual Cajun Festival;  
15 (39) a municipality with a population of 13,000 or  
16 more that:  
17 (A) is located on an international border; and  
18 (B) is located in a county:  
19 (i) with a population of less than 400,000;  
20 and  
21 (ii) in which at least one World Birding  
22 Center site is located;  
23 (40) a municipality with a population of 4,000 or more  
24 that:  
25 (A) is located on an international border; and  
26 (B) is located not more than five miles from a  
27 state historic site that serves as a visitor center for a state park  
28 that contains 300,000 or more acres of land;  
29 (41) a municipality with a population of 36,000 or  
30 more that is adjacent to at least two municipalities described by  
31 Subdivision (15); ~~and~~



1           (42) a municipality with a population of 28,000 or  
2 more in which is located a historic railroad depot and heritage  
3 center; and

4           (43) a municipality that is the county seat of a county  
5 that borders the Gulf of Mexico and the United Mexican States.

6           SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
