3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 64.009, Election Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
6	(e) A polling place must have two parking spaces reserved
7	for the use of a voter who is unable to enter the polling place
8	without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring the voter's
9	health. Each parking space must be clearly marked with a sign:
10	(1) indicating that the space is reserved for use by a
11	voter who is unable to enter the polling place; and
12	(2) displaying, in large font that is clearly readable
13	from a vehicle, a telephone number that a voter may call to request
14	assistance from an election official at the polling place.
15	SECTION 2. Section 104.004, Election Code, is amended by
16	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
17	(f) The main early voting polling place or other location
18	used for voting under this chapter must have two parking spaces
19	reserved for the use of a voter who is unable to enter the polling
20	place without personal assistance or likelihood of injuring the
21	voter's health. Each parking space must meet the requirements for a
22	parking space under Section 64.009(e). Parking spaces reserved
23	under Section 64.009(e) satisfy the requirements of this
24	subsection.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
