## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the issuance of an air quality permit for a concrete
- 3 plant located in an area of a municipality not subject to zoning
- 4 regulations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 382, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.051991 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 382.051991. CONCRETE PLANT NOT SUBJECT TO MUNICIPAL
- 9 ZONING. (a) Notwithstanding Section 382.0518, 382.05195, or
- 10 382.05196, the commission may issue a permit under this chapter for
- 11 a concrete plant located in an incorporated area of a municipality
- 12 that is not subject to zoning regulations only under Section
- 13 <u>382.05198.</u>
- 14 (b) Notwithstanding Section 382.05199, an applicant for a
- 15 permit issued under Section 382.05198 for a concrete plant located
- 16 in an incorporated area of a municipality that is not subject to
- zoning regulations must comply with Section 382.056.
- SECTION 2. Section 382.051991, Health and Safety Code, as
- 19 added by this Act, applies only to an application for a permit that
- 20 is filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or
- 21 after the effective date of this Act. An application for a permit
- 22 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 23 in effect on the date of filing, and that law is continued in effect
- 24 for that purpose.
