- 2 relating to the signature required on an application for voter 3 registration or for a ballot to be voted by mail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 13.002(a) and (b), Election Code, are 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person desiring to register to vote must submit an 8 application to the registrar of the county in which the person
- 9 resides. Except as provided by Subsection (e), an application must
- 10 be submitted by personal delivery $\underline{\text{or}}$ [7] by mail[7 or by telephonic
- 11 facsimile machine in accordance with Sections 13.143(d) and (d-2)].
- 12 (b) Except for a registration application submitted to the
- 13 Department of Public Safety in accordance with other law, a [A]
- 14 registration application must be in writing and signed by the
- 15 applicant using ink on paper, and an electronic signature or
- 16 photocopied signature is not permitted.
- SECTION 2. Section 13.143(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (d) For purposes of determining the effective date of a
- 20 registration, an application submitted by [÷
- $[\frac{1}{2}]$ mail is considered to be submitted to the
- 22 registrar on the date it is placed with postage prepaid and properly
- 23 addressed in the United States mail[+ or
- 24 [(2) telephonic facsimile machine is considered to be

- 1 submitted to the registrar on the date the transmission is received
- 2 by the registrar, subject to Subsection (d-2)].
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 84.001(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (b) An application must be in writing and signed by the
- 6 applicant <u>using ink on paper</u>. An electronic signature <u>or</u>
- 7 photocopied signature is not permitted.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 13.143(d-2), Election Code, is repealed.
- 9 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 10 application for voter registration or for a ballot to be voted by
- 11 mail submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 12 application for voter registration or for a ballot to be voted by
- 13 mail submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 14 the law in effect when the application was submitted, and the former
- 15 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
