- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 382.05199, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsections (b) and (d) and adding Subsection
- 7 (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) An applicant for an authorization to use a standard
- 9 permit under Section 382.05198 must publish and mail notice under
- 10 this section not later than the earlier of:
- 11 (1) the 30th day after the date the applicant receives
- 12 written notice from the executive director that the application is
- 13 technically complete; or
- 14 (2) the 75th day after the date the executive director
- 15 receives the application.
- 16 <u>(c-1) The applicant must mail written notice to each</u>
- 17 household within 880 yards of the proposed plant.
- 18 (d) The notice under Subsections (c) and (c-1) must include:
- 19 (1) a brief description of the proposed location and
- 20 nature of the proposed plant;
- 21 (2) a description, including a telephone number, of
- 22 the manner in which the executive director may be contacted for
- 23 further information;
- 24 (3) a description, including a telephone number, of

- 1 the manner in which the applicant may be contacted for further
- 2 information;
- 3 (4) the location and hours of operation of the
- 4 commission's regional office at which a copy of the application is
- 5 available for review and copying; and
- 6 (5) a brief description of the public comment process,
- 7 including the time and location of the public hearing, and the
- 8 mailing address and deadline for filing written comments.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 382.05199, Health and Safety Code, as
- 10 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for a permit
- 11 that is filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on
- 12 or after the effective date of this Act. An application for a
- 13 permit filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 14 the law in effect on the date of filing, and that law is continued in
- 15 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
