4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 431 , Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 431.143 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 431.143. MANUFACTURER DISCLOSURE. (a) A manufacturer
8	selling a cosmetic in this state shall disclose on the
9	manufacturer's Internet website:
10	(1) a list of each ingredient in the cosmetic,
11	including a fragrance, flavor, and color additive, in order of
12	predominance except that the ingredients with a concentration of
13	less than one percent may be listed in any order for purposes of
14	protecting a trade secret; and
15	(2) the chemical abstract service number for each
16	listed ingredient.
17	(b) A manufacturer is not required to list the concentration
18	of each ingredient in a cosmetic under Subsection (a).
19	SECTION 2. Section 431.054(a), Health and Safety Code, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	(a) The department may assess an administrative penalty
22	against a person who violates Subchapter B <u>, Section 431.143,</u> or an
23	order adopted or registration issued under this chapter.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
