## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the discharge by certain defendants of fines and costs
- 3 through community service.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 45.041, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (b-6) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-6) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 8 when imposing a fine and costs, the justice or judge may not require
- 9 <u>a defendant who is under the conservatorship of the Department of</u>
- 10 Family and Protective Services or in extended foster care as
- 11 provided by Subchapter G, Chapter 263, Family Code, to pay any
- 12 amount of the fine and costs. If the full amount of the fine and
- 13 costs is not waived under Article 45.0491, the justice or judge
- 14 shall require the defendant to perform community service to
- 15 discharge the unwaived amount of the fine and costs as provided by
- 16 Article 45.049, 45.0492, as added by Chapter 227 (H.B. 350), Acts of
- 17 the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, or 45.0492, as added
- 18 by Chapter 777 (H.B. 1964), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 19 Session, 2011, as appropriate.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 21 sentencing proceeding that commences before, on, or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
