- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 542, Transportation Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 542.2034 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 542.2034. PREEMPTION OF LOCAL AUTHORITIES' REGULATION
- 9 OF USE OF WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE. (a) In this section,
- 10 "wireless communication device" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 11 545.425.

- 12 (b) The authority of a local authority to regulate or
- 13 prohibit the use of a wireless communication device while operating
- 14 a motor vehicle is preempted by this code, including by Sections
- 15 545.424, 545.425, 545.4251, and 545.4252.
- 16 (c) This section does not affect the authority of a local
- 17 <u>authority's peace officers to enforce the laws of this state</u>
- 18 relating to the use of a wireless communication device while
- 19 operating a motor vehicle.
- SECTION 2. Sections 545.425(b-1) and (b-4), Transportation
- 21 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (b-1) A [Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), a] local
- 23 authority whose peace officers enforce [that enforces] this section
- 24 in a school crossing zone in the local authority's jurisdiction

- 1 shall post a sign, or approve the posting of a sign by a school or
- 2 school district, that complies with the standards described by this
- 3 subsection at each entrance to the school crossing zone. The Texas
- 4 Department of Transportation shall adopt standards that:
- 5 (1) allow for a sign required to be posted under this
- 6 subsection to be attached to an existing sign at a minimal cost; and
- 7 (2) require that a sign required to be posted under
- 8 this subsection inform an operator that:
- 9 (A) the use of a wireless communication device is
- 10 prohibited in the school crossing zone; and

- 14 (b-4) The local authority shall pay the costs associated
- 15 with the posting of signs under <u>Subsection</u> [Subsections] (b-1) [and

- SECTION 3. Sections 545.425(b-2), (b-3), (d-1), and (f),
- 19 545.4251(g) and (j), and 545.4252(e), Transportation Code, are
- 20 repealed.
- 21 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 24 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 25 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 26 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 27 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred

- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
