- 3 convicted of certain criminal offenses involving animals.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 42A.511(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) If a judge grants community supervision to a defendant
- 8 convicted of an offense under Section 21.09, 42.09, 42.091, 42.092,
- 9 <u>42.10</u>, or <u>42.105</u>, Penal Code, the judge may:
- 10 (1) require the defendant to relinquish custody of any
- 11 animals in the defendant's possession;
- 12 (2) prohibit the defendant from possessing or
- 13 exercising control over any animals or residing in a household
- 14 where animals are present; or
- 15 (3) require the defendant to participate in a
- 16 psychological counseling or other appropriate treatment program
- 17 for a period to be determined by the court.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 19 defendant placed on community supervision on or after the effective
- 20 date of this Act, regardless of whether the offense for which the
- 21 defendant was placed on community supervision was committed before,
- 22 on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
