A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use of promotoras and community health workers in Medicaid managed care. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 533, Government Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 533.021 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 533.021. PROMOTORAS AND COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS. (a) In this section, "promotora" and "community health worker" have the 8 9 meaning assigned by Section 48.001, Health and Safety Code. (b) The commission shall allow each Medicaid managed care 10 organization providing health care services under the STAR Medicaid 11 12 managed care program to categorize services provided by a promotora or community health worker as a quality improvement cost, as 13 14 authorized by federal law, instead of as an administrative expense. SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 15 16 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 17 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 18 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 19 20 waiver or authorization is granted.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
