## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the apportionment and composition of the districts of 3 the Texas House of Representatives. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to fulfill the Legislature's constitutional responsibility to redistrict the 6 House of Representatives following the publication of the 2020 7 census in compliance with the United States and Texas Constitutions 8 9 and applicable Federal law. SECTION 2. FINDINGS. The Legislature finds: 10 11 (1)Section 28, Article III, Texas Constitution, 12 requires the Legislature to draw new representative districts during the first regular session following publication of the 13 14 decennial census; (2) As a result of the estimated changes in the 15 population of the state since 2013, the populations of the current 16 representative districts are unequal and no longer comply with 17 applicable legal requirements; and 18 19 (3) The current representative districts must be replaced with new districts that satisfy all applicable legal 20 21 requirements. SECTION 3. APPORTIONMENT; COMPOSITION OF DISTRICTS. 22 The 23 State of Texas is apportioned into representative districts as

provided in this Act. Each district is composed of the counties or

1 parts of counties as determined by the Legislature consistent with 2 the requirements of the United States and Texas Constitutions and 3 applicable Federal law. One representative is elected from each 4 district established by this Act.

5 SECTION 4. TRANSITION PROVISION. The districts established 6 by this Act apply to the election of the members of the Texas House 7 of Representatives beginning with the primary and general elections 8 in 2022 for members of the 88th Legislature. This Act does not 9 affect the membership or districts of the Texas House of 10 Representatives of the 87th Legislature.

SECTION 5. REPEALER. Chapter 2 (S.B. 3), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, 1st Called Session, 2013 (Article 195a-13, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is repealed.

14 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 15 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members 16 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas 17 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for 18 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
