## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study by the Texas Water Development Board of
- 3 groundwater conditions in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. In order to engage in a scientific inquiry and
- 6 analysis regarding current and projected groundwater production
- 7 and to assess the effects of that production on groundwater
- 8 conditions, the executive administrator of the Texas Water
- 9 Development Board shall, for the Trinity and Edwards Aquifers north
- 10 of the Colorado River in Bell, Burnet, Milam, Travis, and
- 11 Williamson Counties:
- 12 (1) compile and evaluate current data on groundwater
- 13 levels, aquifer characteristics, and groundwater use and
- 14 production; and
- 15 (2) fully assess the effects of current and projected
- 16 groundwater production on groundwater conditions.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2022, the executive
- 18 administrator of the Texas Water Development Board shall:
- 19 (1) complete the compilation, evaluation, and
- 20 assessment of data described by Section 1 of this Act;
- 21 (2) prepare a report of the findings of the
- 22 compilation, evaluation, and assessment;
- 23 (3) submit the report to each standing committee of
- 24 the legislature having primary jurisdiction over water

- 1 development; and
- 2 (4) make copies of the report available to the public.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act expires September 1, 2023.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
