## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to establishing a program designed to ensure health
3	benefit plan coverage to certain children through the private
4	marketplace.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle I, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
7	by adding Chapter 540 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 540. PROGRAM TO ENSURE HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN COVERAGE FOR
9	CERTAIN CHILDREN THROUGH PRIVATE MARKET SOLUTIONS
10	Sec. 540.0001. PROGRAM FOR HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN COVERAGE FOR
11	CHILDREN THROUGH PRIVATE MARKET SOLUTIONS. The commission in
12	consultation with the commissioner of insurance shall develop and
13	implement a program that helps connect certain children in this
14	state with health benefit plan coverage through private market
15	solutions.
16	Sec. 540.0002. ENROLLMENT ELIGIBILITY. (a) Subject to
17	Subsection (b), a child is eligible to enroll in a program designed
18	and established under this chapter if the child:
19	(1) is younger than 19 years of age;
20	(2) is not eligible for benefits under Medicaid or the
21	child health plan program because of applicable income limits; and
22	(3) does not have health benefit coverage under a
23	health benefit plan because the child's family does not have access
24	to or cannot afford a plan through the private marketplace,

- 1 including:
- 2 (A) an employer-sponsored health benefit plan;
- 3 <u>or</u>
- 4 (B) a health benefit plan for which an enrollee
- 5 <u>receives a premium subsidy under the Patient Protection and</u>
- 6 Affordable Care Act (Pub. L. No. 111-148) due to the amount of
- 7 family income.
- 8 (b) The executive commissioner shall further define the
- 9 program's eligibility requirements, including defining income
- 10 requirements necessary to enroll in the program.
- 11 Sec. 540.0003. MINIMUM PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS. A program
- 12 designed and established under this chapter must:
- 13 <u>(1) provide premium assistance to purchase health</u>
- 14 benefit plan coverage for a child in the private market; and
- 15 (2) use technology to maximize the efficiency with
- 16 which the commission and any health benefit plan issuer manages
- 17 <u>enrollee participation</u>.
- Sec. 540.0004. RULES. The executive commissioner may adopt
- 19 rules necessary to implement this chapter.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 22 Services Commission shall develop and implement the program
- 23 required by Chapter 540, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 25 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 26 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 27 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

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- 1 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 2 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
