A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the continuing education requirement for county
3 commissioners.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 81.0025(a) and (b), Local Government
6 Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A county commissioner must successfully complete at
8 least 16 [~~classroom~~] hours of continuing education in the
9 performance of the duties of county commissioners at least once in
10 each 12-month period.

11 (b) Continuing education instruction required by this
12 section must be certified by an accredited public institution of
13 higher education. The instruction may be completed online, except
14 a county commissioner must complete the instruction in person in
15 the first 12-month period of the commissioner's first term.

16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
