2	relating to juvenile court records of victims of sex trafficking.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 54, Family Code, is amended by adding
5	Section 54.12 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 54.12. TRAFFICKING VICTIM FINDING. (a) This section
7	applies to a child who was referred to a juvenile probation
8	department and whose records include conduct:
9	(1) that constitutes an offense under Section
10	43.02(a), Penal Code; and
11	(2) for which the defense under Section 43.02(d),
12	Penal Code, applies.
13	(b) If applicable, the court shall enter a finding in the
14	case of a child to whom this section applies stating that the child
15	is a victim of trafficking.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter C-1, Chapter 58, Family Code, is
17	amended by adding Section 58.2552 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 58.2552. SEALING RECORDS WITH OR WITHOUT APPLICATION:
19	TRAFFICKING VICTIM. (a) If a juvenile court enters a finding that a
20	child is a victim of trafficking under Section 54.12, the court, on
21	the court's own motion and without a hearing, shall immediately
22	order the sealing of all records of the child that are related to
23	the conduct described under that section.

(b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a child who is entitled

- 1 to have records sealed under that subsection may file an
- 2 application for the sealing of records related to the child's
- 3 applicable conduct in the juvenile court served by the juvenile
- 4 probation department to which the child was referred. The court may
- 5 not charge a fee for filing the application, regardless of the form
- 6 of the application. An application filed under this subsection
- 7 must include the information required under Section 58.256(b).
- 8 (c) On receipt of an application under Subsection (b), the
- 9 court shall immediately order the sealing of the child's records
- 10 related to the applicable conduct without a hearing.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act applies to juvenile court records
- 12 created before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
