A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the composition of districts for the election of
- 3 members of the United States House of Representatives from Texas.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is to fulfill
- 6 the Legislature's constitutional responsibility to establish
- 7 districts for the election of members of the United States House of
- 8 Representatives following the publication of the 2020 census in
- 9 compliance with the United States Constitution and applicable
- 10 Federal and state law and the decennial reapportionment of
- 11 congressional districts among the states.
- 12 SECTION 2. FINDINGS. The Legislature finds:
- 13 (1) 2 U.S.C. Section 2a requires the election of
- 14 members of the United States House of Representatives from
- 15 districts;
- 16 (2) As a result of the estimated changes in the
- 17 population of the state since 2011, the populations of the current
- 18 districts for the election of members of the United States House of
- 19 Representatives are unequal and no longer comply with applicable
- 20 legal requirements; and
- 21 (3) The current districts must be replaced following
- 22 publication of the decennial census with new districts that satisfy
- 23 all applicable legal requirements.
- SECTION 3. COMPOSITION OF DISTRICTS. (a) The State of

- 1 Texas is divided into congressional districts as provided in this
- 2 Act. Each district is composed of the counties or parts of counties
- 3 as determined by the Legislature consistent with the requirements
- 4 of the United States and Texas Constitutions and applicable Federal
- 5 law.
- 6 (b) One member of the United States House of Representatives
- 7 is elected from each district established under this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. TRANSITION PROVISION. The districts established
- 9 by this Act apply to the election of the members of the United
- 10 States House of Representatives of the 118th Congress beginning
- 11 with the primary and general elections in 2022. This Act does not
- 12 affect the membership or districts of members of the United States
- 13 House of Representatives of the 117th Congress.
- 14 SECTION 5. REPEALER. (a) This Act supersedes all previous
- 15 enactments or orders adopting districts for the United States House
- 16 of Representatives. All previous acts of the legislature adopting
- 17 districts for the United States House of Representatives are
- 18 repealed.
- 19 (b) Chapter 3 (S.B. 4), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, 1st
- 20 Called Session, 2013, is repealed.
- 21 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 22 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 23 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 24 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 25 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
